Last week, the USDA extended the Summer Lunch Program through December 31, 2020 for school districts. This allows us to offer a free breakfast and lunch to students and families with children up to the age of 18. We will begin free meals for students enrolled in school on September 8, 2020.


Students that are remotely enrolled or that are not of school age, may also sign up for free meals. It is important to note that meals will not be delivered as they were in the spring. There will be a pick up location designated once the District has a count of families wanting to participate.

If you would like to pick up breakfast and lunch daily, please contact LeaAnn at the district office by calling 618-576-2722. Initial orders will be taken until September 18th. These meals will be ready for pick up on Monday, September 21st. The time and location will be determined following the orders being placed. Information will be sent out to those who sign up.

In addition, we hope that everyone had a successful remote learning day on Friday, September 4th. There will be a survey for parents to complete sent to your email address this week. We continue to monitor the current pandemic and are fortunate to have not needed to cancel any classes or close any buildings. If this situation changes and we are unable to staff classrooms or the number of students on remote learning increases due to COVID-19, we will need to consider a different schedule. In the meantime, don't forget to sign the self-certification daily on the lanyards, encourage students to wash hands, wear their mask, and maintain social distance. If a student is showing any signs of COVID-19 please keep them at home along with any siblings until an alternate diagnosis can be made or a negative test is received.

We will continue to keep you updated of any new guidance as it is received. Remember you can check for information on the school website, Facebook page, or in your email.
